

## MARCOS SABELLI IS PROFERTIL'S NEW GENERAL MANAGER

**Bahía Blanca, October 3 2022** – Marcos Sabelli is the new general manager of Profertil, Argentina's leading fertilizer company. Sabelli replaced Federico Veller.

Until this change, Sabelli was Vice President of Strategy and Business Development at YPF, where YPF's current growth plan was developed. Previously, he led the transformation process that drove the company's evolution towards **a more agile, flexible and technological organization**, focused on the competitiveness of all its operations.

The new general manager also has close ties with Profertil -a company formed by YPF and Nutrien Inc. in equal parts-, as he was chairman of its Board of Directors from 2013 to 2014 and from 2017 to 2018, a role he alternated as vice-chairman during 2012 and from 2015 to 2016..

Sabelli is a professional with extensive experience that covered different functions in Argentina, the United States and Europe. He began his **career of more than 25 years in the oil industry** when he joined YPF's La Plata Industrial Complex in 1994. In addition, he was president of the Latin American Petrochemical and Chemical Association (APLA), which groups the main companies of the sector in the continent, and he continues to be a member of its advisory board at present.

His basic training is in Petroleum Engineering at the Instituto Tecnológico de Buenos Aires (ITBA). He then completed a Master's degree in Petroleum and Natural Gas Economics at the same institution, a specialization in which he currently teaches. He also obtained a Diploma in Shipping and Crude Oil Trading from the University of Cambridge and a Diploma from the Management Development Program of the IAE Business School.

Sabelli joins the company at a time of great future projection: Profertil has positioned itself as a benchmark in sustainability and care for natural resources, and seeks to continue growing with this in mind.
