



Profertil presents its eleventh Sustainability Report - 2021

Bahía Blanca, October 12, 2022 –Profertil presents its eleventh Sustainability Report: a document that reports on the actions that the company conducted throughout the year 2021 to continue accompanying the production of more and better food, taking care of the natural resources that make it possible. More than a decade of reports underlines the commitment and responsibility of the agribusiness company to work in an increasingly sustainable way.

As a novelty, this eleventh edition replaces in Spanish the concept of "sustentabilidad" with "sostenibilidad", to focus on actions related to the triple bottom line -social, economic, and environmental-, which becomes evident in the development and growth of the company. The move towards sustainability is aligned with the main global trends and with the Sustainable Development Goals proposed by the United Nations in the agenda of goals for the year 2030.

As usual, Profertil's Sustainability Report is prepared in accordance with the GRI (Global Reporting Initiative) standards, which represent the best global practices for publicly reporting the economic, environmental, and social impacts of an organization. In addition, this year the material indicators for the Resource Transformation Sector (Chemical Substances) of the Sustainability Accounting Standard Board (SASB) were included. In this way, the Report complies with the requirement to adhere to the United Nations Global Compact by identifying the main sustainability issues that have a direct impact on the industrial sector.

Main milestones of the Report

During 2021, Profertil celebrated its twentieth anniversary in Ingeniero White, where its main production plant is located. In this context, the largest plant turnaround in its history was conducted, lasting more than 60 days. During this period, more than 2,500 maintenance tasks were executed, which implied the incorporation of more than 1,500 contractors and 50 specialists from abroad, in addition to the company's permanent staff.

Since its origins, Profertil has shown its open-door policy to the community; and the Plant Visits Program also celebrated its 20th anniversary in 2021.

Another important milestone that shows the company's professionalism and transparency was the placement of class 1 Negotiable Obligations in the local market, with results that exceeded initial expectations. The amount issued is used for projects aimed at increasing production, providing the company with working capital and reinforcing the sustainability of its production complex.

Profertil's main objective is to position itself as a sustainable company that cares for our country's natural resources. For this reason, more than 60% of the urea production is made from renewable energies: it has

work teams specially dedicated to research and dissemination of best practices in product handling and continues to purchase residual carbon dioxide from the company Mega to use it as raw material in its processes.

In line with its commitment to care for the environment and the responsible use of resources, the eleventh edition of the Sustainability Report is presented in digital format; redesigned and optimized to show the information in an agile, practical, and dynamic way for users.
