



100% of Profertil's production will be powered by renewable electric energy from YPF

Ingeniero White, June 28, 2023 - Profertil entered into an agreement with YPF Luz whereby 100% of the electric power consumed at its granulated urea plant will come from wind energy sources. The agreement has a duration of 10 years and adds to the one signed in 2018, which already supplied 60% of the company's electricity requirement. The new agreement provides 95 GWh/year, the equivalent of 23,730 homes. The reduction in CO2 emissions is estimated at 26,000 tons per year which, added to the 50,500 reduced by the previous contract, brings to 0 the scope 2 greenhouse gas emissions, i.e., those linked to the provision of electricity.

Marcos Sabelli, Profertil's CEO, said that "the agreement with YPF Luz is a new milestone in our journey towards sustainable production. It is the result of the effort of a great team that is committed to an agriculture that takes care of the resources in every step of the process."

With this agreement, energy from the new wind farm General Levalle (Córdoba) will be added to the energy supplied by YPF Luz from the wind farms Los Teros (Azul) and Manantiales Behr (Comodoro Rivadavia). General Levalle wind farm has the latest generation wind turbines in the country, which reach 200 m high and a power of 6.2 MW each.

Martín Mandarano, YPF Luz CEO, pointed out: "We are proud that companies like Profertil, which work with awareness and respect for the environment, choose us as their strategic ally to continue producing with clean energies."

With the granulated urea that will be generated with 100% wind energy, 11 million hectares can be fertilized, the equivalent of 1/3 of the province of Buenos Aires or 2/3 of the province of Cordoba. On that surface, Argentina is capable of producing 40 million tons of grain, which, to estimate the size, would load 1,400,000 trucks. Lined up in a row, the vehicles would go around the circumference of the Earth twice.

This agreement is part of a lengthy line of sustainable milestones that Profertil has been conducting since the beginning of its operations. The company's purpose - to nourish the land in a sustainable way - is translated into concrete actions, from production to the delivery of the final product to the field.
