PROFERTIL informs the community

Ingeniero White, May 21. The company informs that urea production at its plant has been stopped today due to a variation in the power supply. Once the inspection tasks have been completed, start-up maneuvers will begin, and it is estimated that this process will be completed within the next 24 hours. As usual in this type of tasks, the plant flares are expected to be brighter and, eventually and sporadically, the sound level will increase.

The increase in noise is due to the heating of the facilities when the process gases are recirculated, while the increased brightness of the flares is linked to the safe and controlled combustion of waste gases.

This entire process is a normal part of the plant's operation, in accordance with the design and international safety standards. The process is expected to be completed during Monday, with the plant back in operation.
