Profertil, the leading company in urea and fertilizer production for agriculture presented its twelfth Sustainability Report with great enthusiasm. For the first time in its history, it was done through a live streaming event on its YouTube channel: ProfertilAgro.

As in past years, the Sustainability Report provides a comprehensive account of the initiatives undertaken during the preceding period, all geared towards advancing sustainability in agriculture and enhancing food production. With a history of over a decade of successive reports, Profertil underscores its unwavering dedication and accountability in striving for more sustainable agricultural practices.

In an innovative move, this edition was launched through a live streaming event, featuring an interview with Gabriela Gancedo, the company's Community Relations Coordinator. The conversation provided valuable insights into the creation of the report and the major sustainability milestones attained in 2022. Here are some key points from the twelfth report:

- **Production record:** In 2022, Profertil reached its all-time highest urea production, hitting 1,377,821 tons of the most important nitrogen fertilizer for agriculture. And this record becomes even more significant considering that it was achieved during the same period in which the company **reduced natural gas consumption**, increased the supply

of electricity from **renewable sources**, and **decreased water consumption** per ton of urea produced.

- **Two new managerial positions are paving the way!** The Strategy and Sustainable Development management provides a comprehensive view of all sustainability initiatives within the company. Meanwhile, the Supply Chain management unifies Profertil's procurement processes to improve coordination and efficiency.

- **Diversity and inclusion board and community:** Two cross-functional spaces were established within all work areas to develop, coordinate, and enhance a diverse climate within the company.

- **Recertification of the Protect and Sustain Program:** The International Fertilizer Association (IFA) recertified Profertil in this program, acknowledging the safety and sustainability of Profertil in the comprehensive management of fertilizer throughout its lifecycle. This collaboration involves suppliers, carriers, and business partners who share the same values. This is the highest certification a plant like Profertil can aspire to achieve.
